## Show Rules and Regulations

1. The show management reserves the right to vary the list of show officials and classes at its discretion.
2. ASTM approved helmets are required on anyone who is mounted.
3. Dogs must be on a leash.
4. **Warm-ups:** Riders must submit their number at the in-gate by 7:30 am.
5. Unjudged warm-up will end promptly at 8:45 am.
6. **Entry fees:**  
\$12 per class  
\$15 per Medal class  
\$5 per unjudged warm-up  
A late fee of \$10 will be charged for each horse not pre-entered prior to Thursday, July 16.
7. Phone entries will not be accepted without exceptions.
8. Refunds will be given only with a vet's or doctor's certificate.
9. Asterisk (\*) before classes represent non-pointed classes

## RING ONE

### Modified Hunter

Fences not to exceed 2'3". Riders cannot have shown over 2'6" at any recognized horse show.

### Modified Equation

Fences not to exceed 2'3". Riders cannot have shown over 2'6" at any recognized horse show and cannot cross enter into other equitation classes

4. Modified Equitation on the Flat
5. Modified Equation Over Fences 2'3"

#### 6. **Granite State Children's Medal 2'3"**

Fences not to exceed 2'3". Junior riders must perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. A minimum of three riders must complete the course. USEF Tests 1-18 may be requested upon the discretion of the judge.

#### 7. **Downeast Children's Medal 2'3"**

Fences not to exceed 2'3". Junior riders must perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. 25% of contestants (minimum of 2 riders) shall be called back for individual testing, USEF Tests 1-8.

#### 8. **Granite State Modified Adult Medal 2'3"**

Fences not to exceed 2'3". Amateur riders 18 years or older must perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. A minimum of three riders must complete the course. USEF Tests 1-18 may be requested upon the discretion of the judge.

#### 9. **Downeast Modified Adult Medal 2'3"**

Fences not to exceed 2'3". Amateur riders 18 years or older must perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. 25% of contestants (minimum of 2 riders) shall be called back for individual testing, USEF Tests 1-8.

#### 10. **Granite State Pony Medal**

Fences not to exceed 2'3" for small and medium ponies and 2'6" for large ponies. Junior pony riders must perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. A minimum of three riders must complete the course. USEF Tests 1-18 may be requested upon the discretion of the judge.

#### 11. **Downeast Pony Medal 2'3"**

Fences not to exceed 2'3" for small and medium ponies and 2'6" for large ponies. Junior pony riders must perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. 25% of contestants (minimum of 2 riders) shall be called back for individual testing, USEF Tests 1-19.

### Children's Hunter Pony

Fences not to exceed 2'9" and fence spread not to exceed fence height. Junior exhibitors may not have won 12 blue ribbons at any recognized show. Same horse/rider combinations may not compete in any other rated hunter divisions at the same show. To be split to horse and pony if entries warrant.

### Children's Hunter Horse

Fences not to exceed 2'9" and fence spread not to exceed fence height. Junior exhibitors may not have won 12 blue ribbons at any recognized show. Same horse/rider combinations may not compete in any other rated hunter divisions at the same show. To be split to horse and pony if entries warrant.

#### 27. **Granite State Amateur Adult Medal 2'9"**

Fences not to exceed 2'9". Amateur riders 18 years or older must perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. A minimum of three riders must complete the course. USEF Tests 1-18 may be requested upon discretion of the judge.

#### 28. **Downeast Amateur Adult Medal 2'9"**

Fences not to exceed 2'9". Amateur riders 18 years or older must perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. 25% of contestants (minimum of 2 riders) shall be called back for individual testing, USEF Tests 1-19.

#### 29. **Granite State Junior Medal 2'9"**

Fences not to exceed 2'9". Junior riders must perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. A minimum of three riders must complete the course. USEF Tests 1-18 may be requested upon discretion of the judge.

#### 30. **Downeast Junior Medal 2'9"**

Fences not to exceed 2'9". Junior riders must perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. 25% of contestants (minimum of 2 riders) shall be called back for individual testing, USEF Tests 1-19.

## RING TWO

### Lead-Line Equitation Division

Open to riders 8 years of age and under. Not to show in any other class/divisions at the same show. Leader and side-walkers must be over the age of 14.

### Beginning Walk-Trot

Open to beginning riders of any age. To be shown at the walk and trot with diagonals not to count. Riders may be assisted in the ring as necessary.

### Walk-Trot Equitation

Open to riders 10 years of age and under. No child entered may compete in any other class requiring entries to canter or lope at the current show. May not have cantered or loped in any class at a recognized show.

### Pony Hunter Pleasure

Open to all ponies of a hunter type. Adults permitted to show ponies with suitability to count; light contact with pony's mouth required. To be judged on performance, manners, quality, presence, suitability, substance, and soundness.

### Hunter Horse Pleasure

Open to all horses of a hunter type. Light contact with horse's mouth required. To be judged on performance, manners, quality, presence, suitability, substance, and soundness.

### Short-Stirrup Equitation

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders cannot have shown over 18" at any recognized show.

### Short-Stirrup Hunter

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders cannot have shown over 18" at any recognized show and may not compete in any other hunter division where fences are higher than 18".

### Long-Stirrup Equitation

Open to riders 13 years of age and older. Riders cannot have shown over 18" at any recognized show.

### 53. *Granite State 18" Novice Medal*

Fences not to exceed 18". Junior and adult riders who have not previously shown over 18" must perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. A minimum of three riders must complete the course. USEF Tests 1-18 may be requested upon the discretion of the judge.

### 54. *Downeast Junior Mini-Medal*

Fences not to exceed 18". Junior riders must perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. 25% of contestants (minimum of 2 riders) shall be called back for individual testing, USEF Tests 1-8.

### Suitable Hunter Division

Open to beginning riders or beginning horses of any age. Horse/rider combinations may not have competed over 18" at any recognized show. Shown over 4 to 8 fences of 18" with no combinations.

## RING THREE

### High Five Beginning Walk-Trot

Open to beginning riders of any age. To be shown at the walk and trot with diagonals not to count. Riders may be assisted in the ring as necessary. Riders may be asked to halt and perform the sitting trot. Riders in this division may not ride in any other class or division requiring cantering.
