2. ASTM approved helmets are required on anyone who is mounted.
3. Show jackets not required in Ring 2.
4. Dogs must be on a leash.
5. **Warm-ups:** 7:30 - 8:45 AM.
6. Unjudged warm-up will end promptly at 8:45 AM.
7. **Entry Fees:** \$12 per class \$5 per unjudged warm-up
8. A late fee of \$10 will be charged for each horse not pre-entered prior to the Thursday before the show date.
9. Phone entries will not be accepted without exceptions.

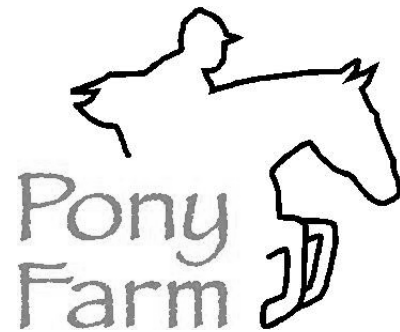

FROM BOSTON:

- Take I 95 or 495 to Rt. 3 North.
- Get off at Exit 8, take Rt. 101A West.
- At the stop light in Milford go left to pick up Rt. 101 West toward Peterborough and Keene.
- At the end of the Milford by-pass, turn left at the stoplight, staying on Rt. 101 West.
- Go just over 9 miles and look for the blue Pony Farm highway sign.
- At the junction of Rt. 101 and 45 turn right.
- Go 1 1/2 miles. Keep right at the fork. Immediately after descending a steep hill you will cross a small bridge. The first driveway on your left will have signs to Pony Farm, Horse Power.

FROM MAINE AND NORTHERN NH:

- Get on Rt. 101 West.
- At the stop light in Milford go left to pick up Rt. 101 West toward Peterborough and Keene.
- At the end of the Milford by-pass, turn left at the stoplight, staying on Rt. 101 West.
- Go just over 9 miles and look for the blue Pony Farm highway sign.
- At the junction of Rt. 101 and 45 turn right.
- Go 1 1/2 miles. Keep right at the fork. Immediately after descending a steep hill you will cross a small bridge. The first driveway on your left will have signs to Pony Farm, Horse Power.

FROM VERMONT:

- Take Rt. 9 East from Brattleboro and pick up Rt. 101 East in Keene.
- In Keene, turn right onto Rt. 101 East.
- Stay on Rt. 101 through Dublin and Peterborough and up over Temple Mountain.
- On the far side of Temple Mountain look for the blue Pony Farm highway sign.
- At the junction of Rts. 101 and 45 turn left.
- Go 1 1/2 miles. Keep right at the fork. Immediately after descending a steep hill you will cross a small bridge. The first driveway on your left will have signs to Pony Farm, Horse Power.

Lead-Line Equitation Division

Open to riders 8 years of age and under. Not to show in any other class/division at the same show. Leaders and side-walkers must be over the age of 14.

Walk-Trot Equitation

Open to riders 10 years of age and under. No child entered may compete in any other class requiring entries to canter or lope at the current show. May not have cantered or loped in any class at a recognized show.

Open Walk-Trot

Open to riders of any age. No rider entered may compete in any other class requiring entries to canter or lope at the current show. May not have cantered or loped in any class at a recognized show.

Short-Stirrup Equitation

Short-Stirrup Hunter

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders cannot have shown over 18" at any recognized show and may not compete in any other hunter division where fences are higher than 18".

Long-Stirrup Equitation

Open to riders 13 years of age and older. Riders cannot have shown over 18" at any recognized show.

Suitable Hunter Division

Open to beginning riders or beginning horses of any age. Horse/rider combination may not have competed over 18" at any recognized show. Shown over 4 to 8 fences of 18" with no combinations.
